USE YOUR RIGHTS.



'Hi, I'm Tomasz from Poland. Five months ago, I bought a new washing machine from a trader in Lithuania.'



KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to have defective goods repaired or replaced within two years of purchase throughout the EU. You may have additional rights depending on the laws of your country.
